Assisted LIVING

Anyone who lives in the community and who meets Medicaid eligibility requirements may be able to enroll in Ohio's Assisted Living Waiver Program.

Individuals may qualify if they:

- Are 21 years or older at enrollment;
- Meet relevant Medicaid financial requirements;
- Need assistance with at least two activities of daily living; and
- Are able to pay the state established monthly room and board (rent).

The Area Agency on Aging staff will help determine eligibility. Call 1-800-331-2644 for details.

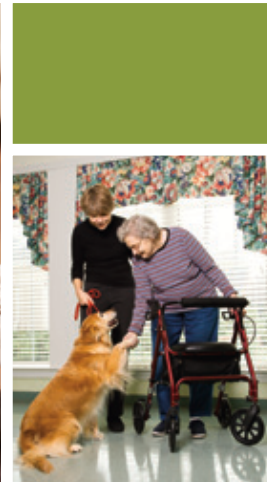


COMMUNITY OF PROVIDERS

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- The Assisted Living Waiver Program pays for a variety of assisted living services. Some participants may be eligible for a one-time allowance to help cover the costs of moving to an assisted living setting.
- All participants also receive a Medicaid card to assist with physician visits, nursing services, therapies and other services.



CONSUMER COSTS

Consumers pay a monthly room and board rate based on the current Social Security benefit rate. Additional costs may apply for some consumers, depending on income. The Area Agency on Aging will help clients understand individual costs under the program.
