Buckeye Hills Area Agency on Aging 8 offers Home Accessibility Modifications and Minor Home Repair for Seniors age 60+. The program is for Senior citizens with mobility and home repair problems in need of assistance with minor home accessibility or repairs to age in place comfortably.

The Area Agency on Aging will assess the home for eligible repairs and develop specifications for repair and bid the project to qualified providers to do the modifications. Households served under this activity must be at or below 35% of Area Median Income and own their home or have a life estate in the property.

Steps to Receive Housing Assistance

1. Call the Area Agency on Aging to determine eligibility. You will be asked some questions pertaining to the problem you need help with and qualifications for assistance.
2. The Housing Coordinator will assess the problem. After the project is determined to meet the requirements for funding, specifications will be written for the work to be completed.
3. Estimates will be requested from contractors that have agreements with the Area Agency on Aging. These contractors may come to your home to estimate the work.
4. When the estimates fall within program guidelines, you will be notified and a proceed order will be sent to the contractor with the lowest estimate.
5. The Housing Coordinator will monitor job progress and answer any questions.

6. When the job has been completed, you will need to sign the Home Owner Work Completion form that the contractor will provide, if you have any questions, contact the Housing Coordinator at 1-800-331-2644.

7. The Housing Coordinator or someone from our Quality Assurance department may make a follow-up call or visit to determine that our standards have been met.

8. In an effort to share the cost of the project with other funding sources that may be available in your area, when job estimates exceed program costs you will be informed and other resources will be researched.



Applicant Requirements

Applicant must meet the thirty five percent (35%) area median income limit at the time of entry into the grant program.
